

## **Parent information sheet**

- **Please find attached an information sheet with the address, gate information and a contact number.**
- **Follow the instructions of our car parking team upon arrival. They will show you where to park. Please be aware that you will be asked to park on a near by car park and walk up to the gym. This is to keep everyone safe.**
- **In the car park and surrounding areas, you are responsible for your gymnast. Please be mindful as it may be busy on the estate.**
- **You must arrive on time. We will be unable to wait for any gymnasts.**

**• In a number of rounds gymnasts will register before parents are allowed in. You may be asked to queue outside whilst the previous rounds exit. Due to this we do advise that you do not arrive too early. Whilst you are waiting you will be able to buy a hot drink from our kitchen. Don't forget to bring your umbrella!**

**• Ensure you have the correct change for the door. We do not accept card on the door. Entry prices are as follows.**

➤ **Adults - £4**

➤ **Children - £2**


**• Due to Covid -19 we are asking that you only bring 2 spectators per gymnast on Thursday, Friday and Saturday and only 1 spectator on Sunday.**

**Unfortunately, we will have to be STRICT with this.**

- **We do advise you to take a negative lateral flow prior to the event. If you do show any signs of COVID 19 please do not attend.**

- **We do also encourage you to wear a mask when inside the building.**


- **There will be a 1 way system to enter and exit the gym. You will enter at the front of the gym and exit via the fire exits at the back. You will then have to walk around the side of the building to the front. We do ask that when exiting the building between rounds you are quick, effective and efficient.**



- **We do ask that you keep all your child's personal belongings with you. This includes shoes, coats etc.**

- **As previous years we are asking you to make a number for your gymnasts. These should be winter/Christmas themed. We are asking for them to be no bigger than A3 so that the children can carry them. Please refrain from using cotton wool as this does get stuck to the equipment. We still want them to be as fantastic as ever and we can't wait to see them.**


- **We will have a kitchen running throughout the event. This will sell both hot and cold food and drinks.**

- **Please respect that the competition venue is a working gym. We take a lot of pride in it and ask you to be respectful and use the bins provided.**

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- **If you have any questions through out the event please approach one of our staff members who will be happy to help. All our staff can be recognised by Wire lanyards which will clearly state their role.**
