

Parent Information

Please be aware that you will be asked to park on a near by car park and walk up to the gym. This is to keep everyone safe.

Do NOT pull the entrance gates onto the site.

In the car park and surrounding areas you are responsible for your gymnast. Please be mindful as it may be busy on the estate.

You must arrive on time. We will be unable to wait for any gymnasts.

We will wait for the previous round to exit before opening the doors for the round. Due to this we do advise that you do not arrive too early. Don't forget to bring your umbrella!

To help speed up entry we advise that you have the correct change for the door. This will help to get everyone out of the cold as quickly as possible. We do accept card on the door. Entry prices are as follows.

Adults - £8

Children - £5

Whilst we have a large number of seats available, these are at a first come first serve basis. There will also be room to stand and spectate.

We do have a VIP Area which is first come first serve. This will be £12 per person entry. This can be purchased on the day. It will only have limited spaces available.

All gymnasts will register in through the furthest door of the gym. This is at the very top of the car park. We do ask that you keep all your child's personal belongings with you. This includes shoes, coats etc.

As previous years we are asking you to make a number for your gymnasts. These should be winter/Christmas themed. We are asking for them to be no bigger than A3 so that the children can carry them. Please refrain from using cotton wool as this does get stuck to the equipment. We do also ask that you take these home at the end of your child's competition. We still want them to be as fantastic as ever and we can't wait to see them.

We will have a kitchen running throughout the event. This will sell both hot and cold food and drinks.

In each round we will also be selling raffle tickets in which the raffle will be announced during presentation.

In some rounds gymnasts will be split across our 2 sprung floors. This will mean the entrance will be different. If your child is highlighted in blue on the running order and starts on floor please enter via unit E1. This will be the same entrance as gymnast registration. Please make sure you have read this and enter via the correct door.

Please respect that the competition venue is a working gym. We take a lot of pride in it and ask you to be respectful and use the bins provided.

If you have any questions through out the event please approach one of our staff members who will be happy to help. All our staff can be recognised by Wire lanyards which will clearly state their role.

We do have a number of First aiders and Welfare officers present throughout the whole weekend. If you require one of these please ask one of our Wire staff.
