ADDRESS

GATES

- ★ It is really important that you do **NOT** pull the entrance gate onto the site. These are monitored and there is CCTV.
- ★ There is a keypad on the side of the gate. Press A1 on the keypad. The intercom will ring, and someone will answer.
- ★ You will be asked for a password. The password for the competition is **"GYMNAST"**. It is important you give this exact password otherwise they will be unable to open the gates.

PARKING

- ★ Please follow our staff's instructions in regards to car parking.
- ★ You will be asked to park on a nearby car park and walk up to the venue.

ARRIVAL & ENTRANCE

- ★ You must arrive on time. We will be unable to wait for any gymnasts.
- ★ We will wait for the previous round to exit before opening the doors for the round. Due to this we advise that you don't arrive too early.
- ★ Don't forget to bring your umbrella!
- ★ All gymnasts will register in the waiting area located at the bottom of the car park. We do ask that you keep all your child's personal belongings with you. This includes shoes and coats.
- ★ Whilst we have a large number of seats available, these are at a first come first serve basis. There will also be room to stand and spectate.

- ★ We have a new VIP viewing area. This is our new upstairs area which has a fantastic view of the gym. There will be limited VIP tickets which you can purchase on the day.
- ★ Entry prices are as follows.
 - Adults - £6
 - Children - £3
 - VIP ticket - £9
- ★ We will be accepting cash and card payments.
- ★ If your gymnast is highlighted in blue on the running order they will be competing on our white floor. The entrance will be via the far end of the gym near gymnast registration.
- ★ We do ask that when exiting the building between rounds you are quick, effective and efficient.

NUMBERS

- ★ As previous years we are asking you to make a number for your gymnasts.
- ★ These should be Winter/Christmas themed.
- We are asking for them to be no bigger than A3 so that the children can carry them.
- Please refrain from using cotton wool as this does get stuck to the equipment.
- We do also ask that you take these home at the end of your child's competition.
- We still want them to be as fantastic as ever and we can't wait to see them.

GENERAL

- ★ We will have a kitchen running throughout the event. This will sell both hot and cold food and drinks.
- ★ In each round we will also be selling raffle tickets
- ★ In some rounds gymnasts will be split across our 2 sprung floors. This will mean the entrance will be different. If your child is highlighted in blue on the running order please enter via unit E1. This will be the entrance next to gymnast registration.
- ★ Please make sure you have read this and enter via the correct door.
- ★ Please respect that the competition venue is a working gym. We take a lot of pride in it and ask you to be respectful and use the bins provided.
- ★ If you have any questions throughout the event please approach one of our staff members who will be happy to help.
- ★ All our staff can be recognised by Wire lanyards which will clearly state their role.
- ★ We do have a number of first aiders and welfare officers present throughout the whole weekend.
