WGC Viewing Policy

Warrington Gymnastics Club believes in an open policy and does not restrict viewing during classes. With the exception of parent/guardians of preschool gymnast's viewing is **only** permitted from the upstairs viewing area.

Warrington Gymnastics Club would like all parents/guardians and visitors to be mindful that participants, especially young children, can be very distracted by individuals in the viewing area. Therefore, we ask that you in **no way** try to communicate with your child or coaches during classes.

Please ensure siblings and other children are supervised at all times. Distraction can affect the ability of coaches to conduct their classes, the effectiveness of the participants classes, and the safety of all participants.

We also ask everyone to keep in mind that our Club viewing areas are open to all and we ask that you are mindful of others during conversations.

Should viewing become disruptive to training, the club or others, Warrington Gymnastics Club reserves the right to restrict viewing time.

If a parent/guardian or visitor continues to be disruptive, Warrington Gymnastics Club reserves the right to restrict their viewing access.

Parents/guardians and visitors are **not to enter the gym areas for any reason**. Do not approach or interrupt coaches during training periods.

If you need to speak to your child's coach briefly, please do so after or prior to the following class. In some cases, the coach may have to begin their next class right away and will be unable to speak to you at this time. If so, you can direct an email to info@warringtongymnastics.co.uk with any questions or concerns you may have or alternatively speak with the office.

In the interest of child protection Warrington Gymnastics Club has a **strict no photography or video policy**. Parents/guardians or visitors found to be taking photographs or videos may be asked to delete any images or video's in their possession.

The upstairs viewing area is also used as a party room and we would therefore ask that parents please ensure the areas are left clean and tidy.
